Everything we heard along the way was resounding millenary melodies, every gesture was the heritage of culture, such as the sublime refinement of both techniques and materials.

We visited villages and explored the wild searching for fabrics, but what we brought back home was way more valuable. Those initial travels became a chance to discover the quality of hand-made rugs and to pursue the perfect texture. That was how it started. Along the way and through the years design evolved and so Sirecom responded with its characteristic shapes expressing feelings and ideas in wefts.

The epicenter of Europe, Design and Fashion is what we call home. Milano is the heart of a unique culture for design, a city where Bauhaus and Cubism echoed the historicity of Bizantine flourishing and Roman aesthetics.

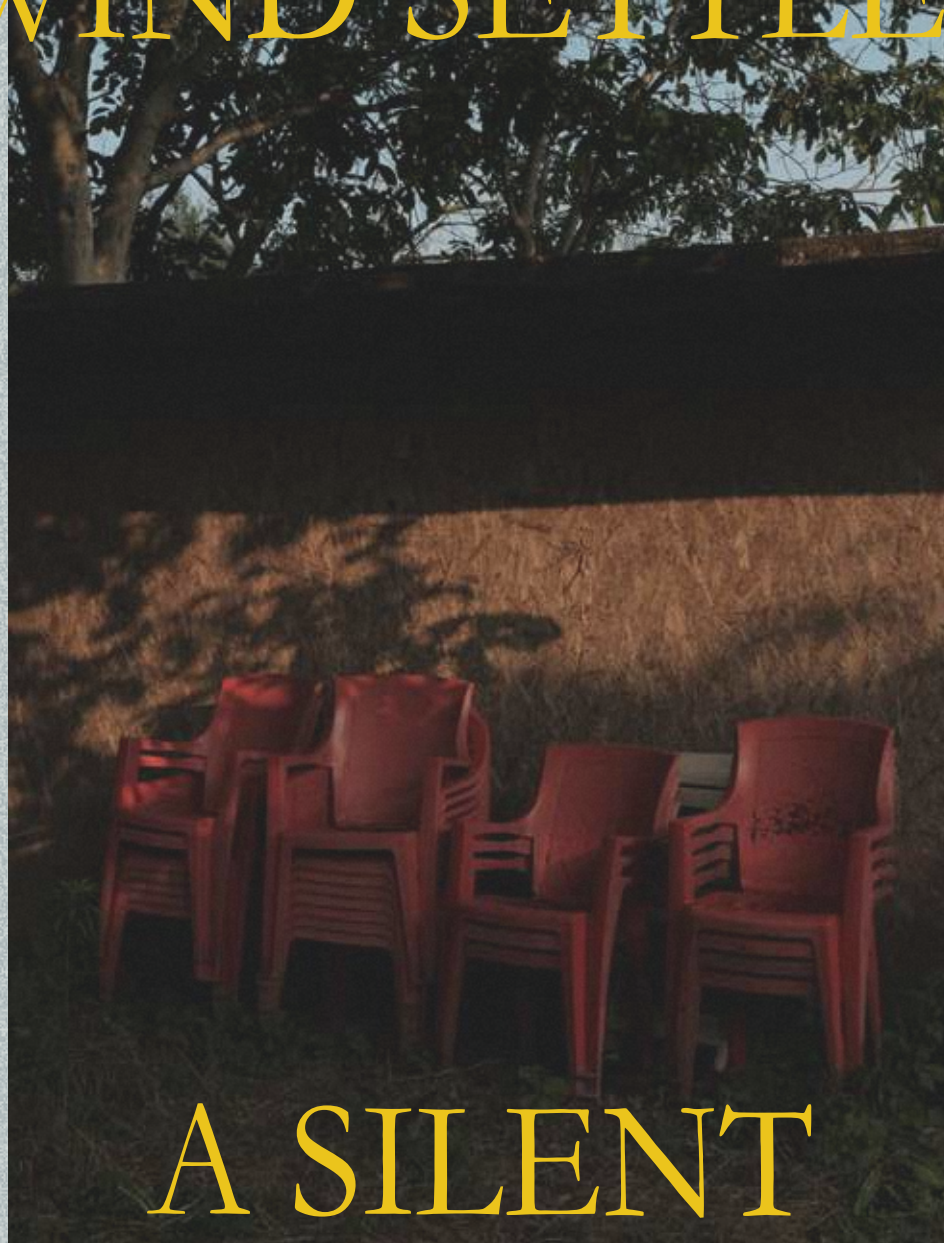
Here we observed ancient codes and values through the lens of a modern sensibility where living is an art.

breathe, the glance we take. When the sun hangs low in the sky, casting long shadows across the land, there exists a story woven from the threads of brotherhood.





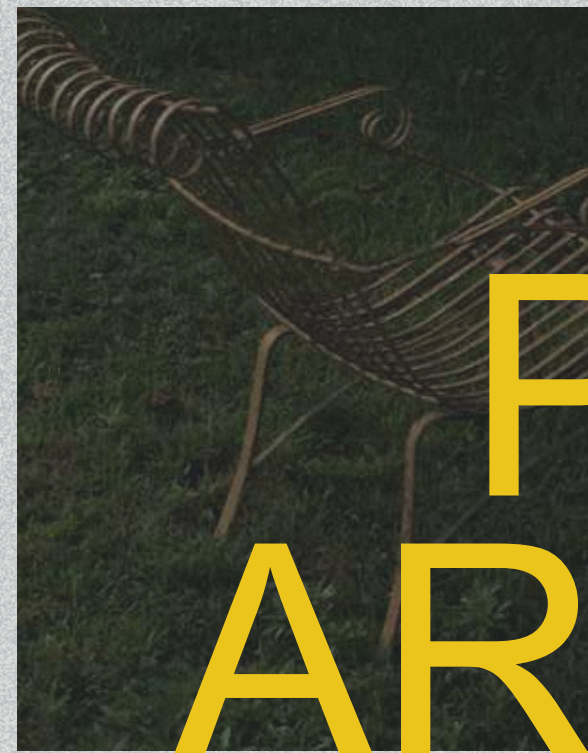

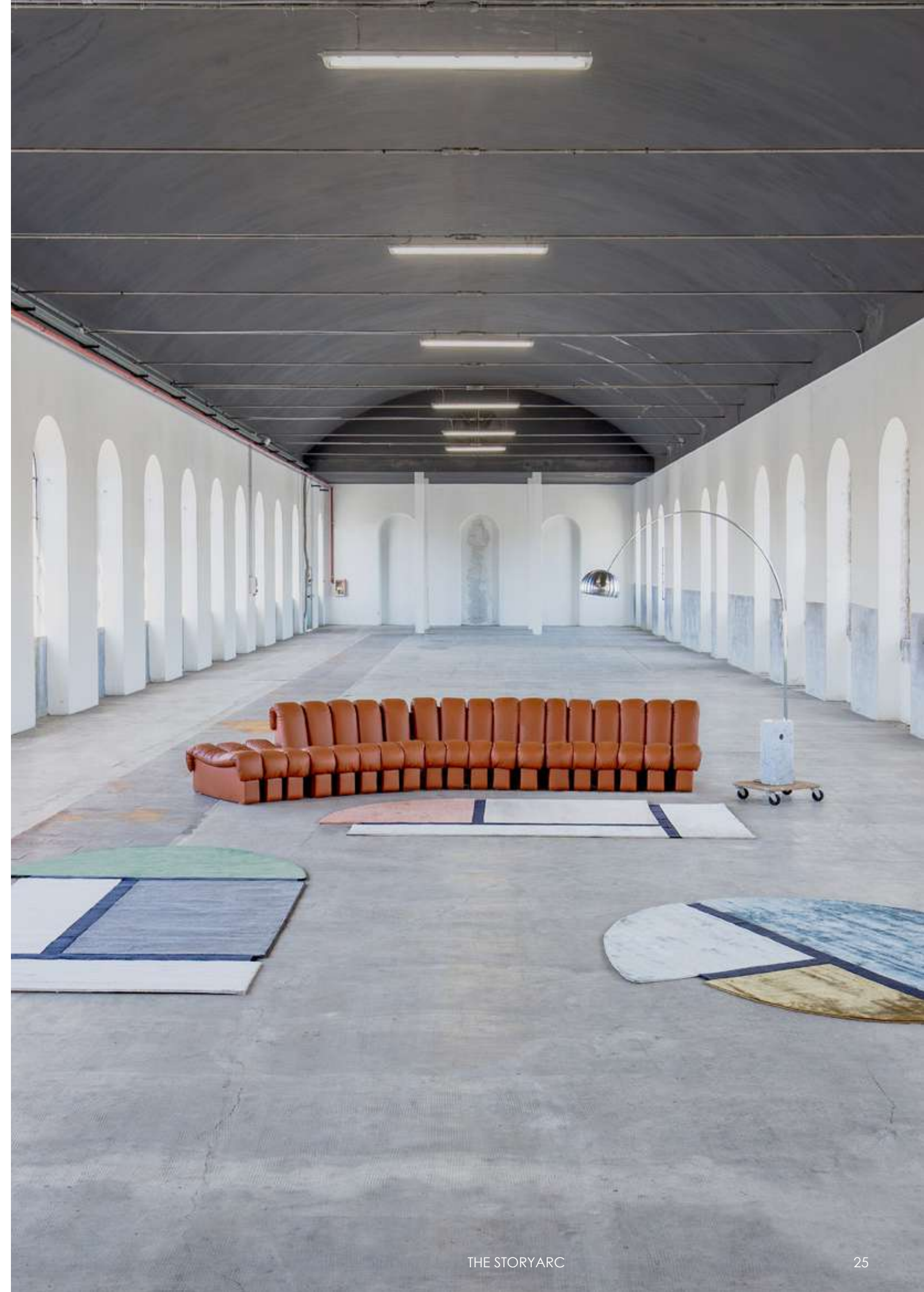

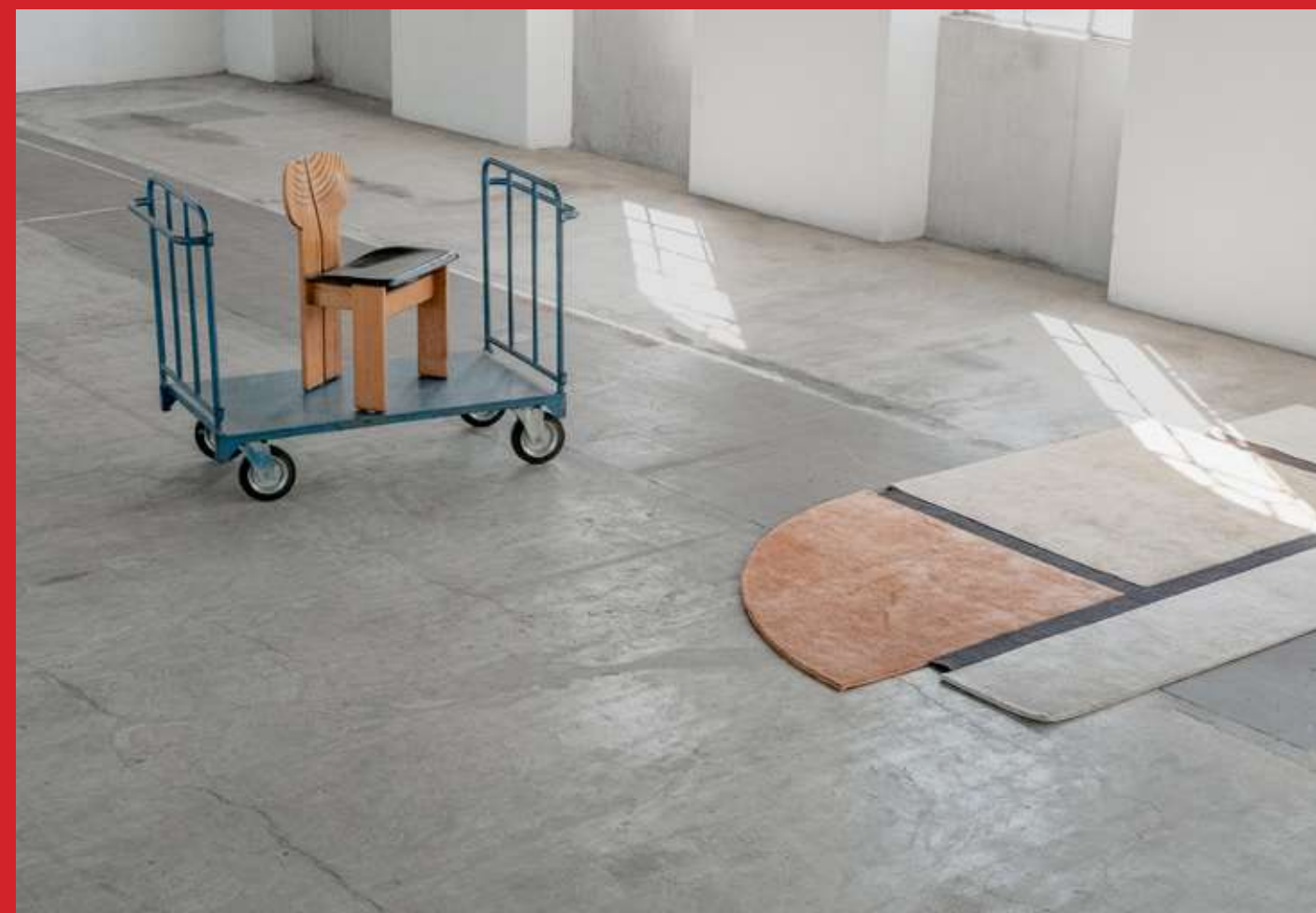

Nube Architettura uses architectural research as the foundation of its design process to integrate rugs seamlessly within living spaces. The studio's aim is to conceptualize carpets as highly adaptable creative components, shaping their design through a volumetric and sculptural approach, counterbalancing conventional graphic representations. To achieve this result, Nube concentrated on material and technical aspects, identifying the design's focal point in the characteristics of the carpet material. Collaborating closely with Sirecom and Nepalese artisans, the studio drew upon a diverse array of techniques. The culmination of this effort is reflected in three novel collections, wherein the rug is perceived as an integral element of the space, enhancing and safeguarding designated areas while facilitating fluid movement within its vicinity. The color palettes of these collections are meticulously curated to be tone-on-tone, strategically harmonizing with the inherent luminosity of the spaces by alternating between brilliance and opacity.

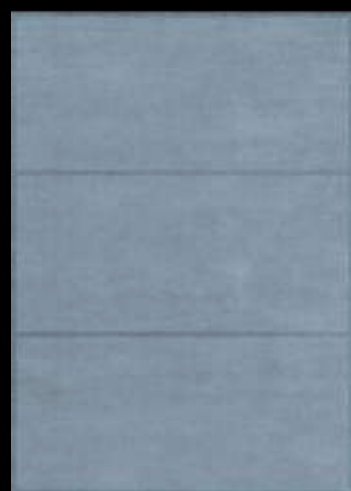

Minimalist blocks of regular volumes accented with luminous lines serve as the cornerstone of the concept. The inspiration behind the “*Sintesi*” collection derives from the reinterpretation of basic geometries such as cubes, rectangles, and slabs, evoking clear architectural influences. These elements are employed to imbue the environment with a functional modular coherence.

The repetitive arrangement of these blocks accentuates the simplicity and uniformity of the shapes, while instilling a sense of rhythm and spatial progression. Principal volumes crafted from New Zealand wool are intersected by delicate luminous corridors achieved through the use of bamboo silk and precise cutwork at varying heights.

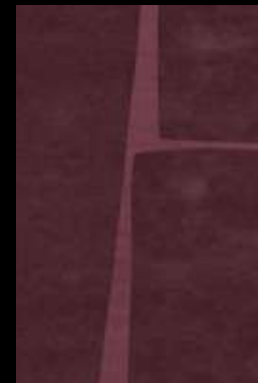

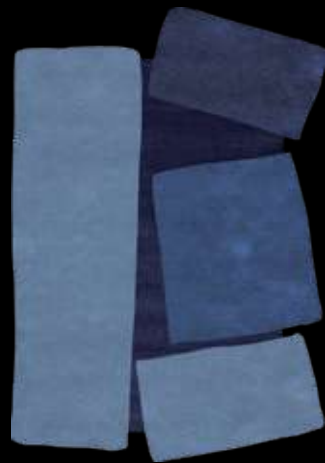

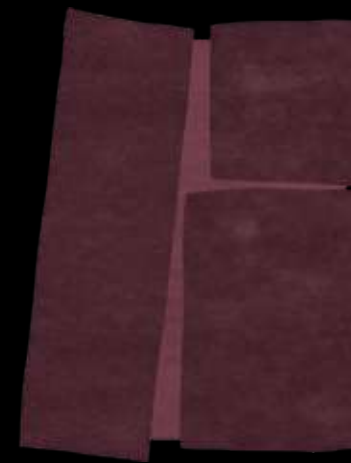

A missive to the cosmos, where the essence of simplicity converges with the extraordinary. This collection embarks on a journey beyond mere symbolism, embracing volumes liberated from the constraints of conventional forms. Illuminated by the radiance of bamboo silk, a luminous bed serves as the focal point, crowned by irregular, sinuous, and opaque volumes that transcend the confines of predefined contours, forging new rhythmic patterns. Central

to the ethos of the “*Lettera*” collection is the aspiration to craft an element that seamlessly integrates into the living environment, imbued with character and poetic resonance. Hand-knotted from 100-knot New Zealand wool, expansive opaque stones hover delicately on the surface, effortlessly approaching, retreating, and intertwining with one another.

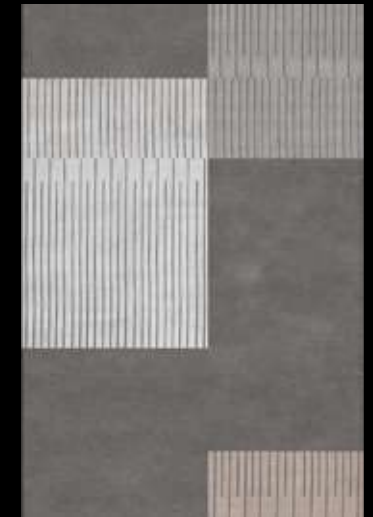

Natural gesture to restore a free element. “*Libero*” embodies a sculptural gesture of reduction, wherein material is selectively removed to unveil its essence. Here, expansive areas of bamboo silk gleam, juxtaposed against an opaque backdrop of New Zealand wool. The interplay of brilliant irregular lines crossing the rug stems from a quest for a natural flow, imparting both

subtlety and dynamism to the space. The collection achieves a delicate balance between functionality and organic allure through the interweaving of various techniques. The alternating heights, meticulous manual knotting, and reinterpretation of the traditional abrash technique on wool imbue the pieces with a rich patina, evoking a sense of preciousness.

The refined use of hand-loomed bamboo silk informs the essential rhythms of the collection. Inspired by the movements of the chessboard, Shogi defines the aesthetic synthesis of colorful and discreet harmonies capable of accompanying every living activity in an elegant and sophisticated way. The carving bas-reliefs whisper a dynamic attitude in the softest shades, while the blocks of color in her heart shine the technical art in the juxtaposition of twisted and knotted.

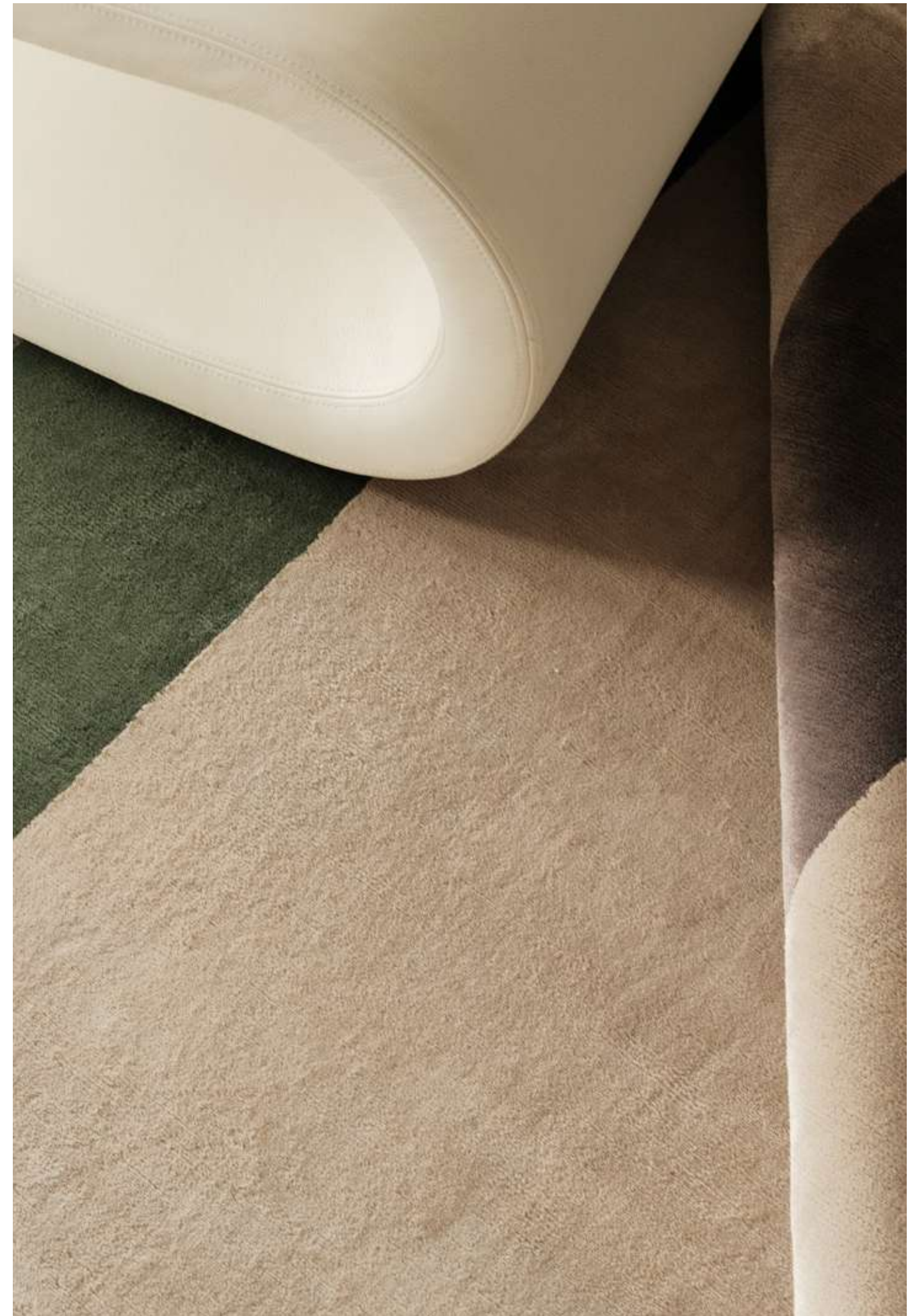

The design modulate light and shadows over three different layers of width to emphasize the shiny yarns and vibrant tones.

SARNICO PROJECT

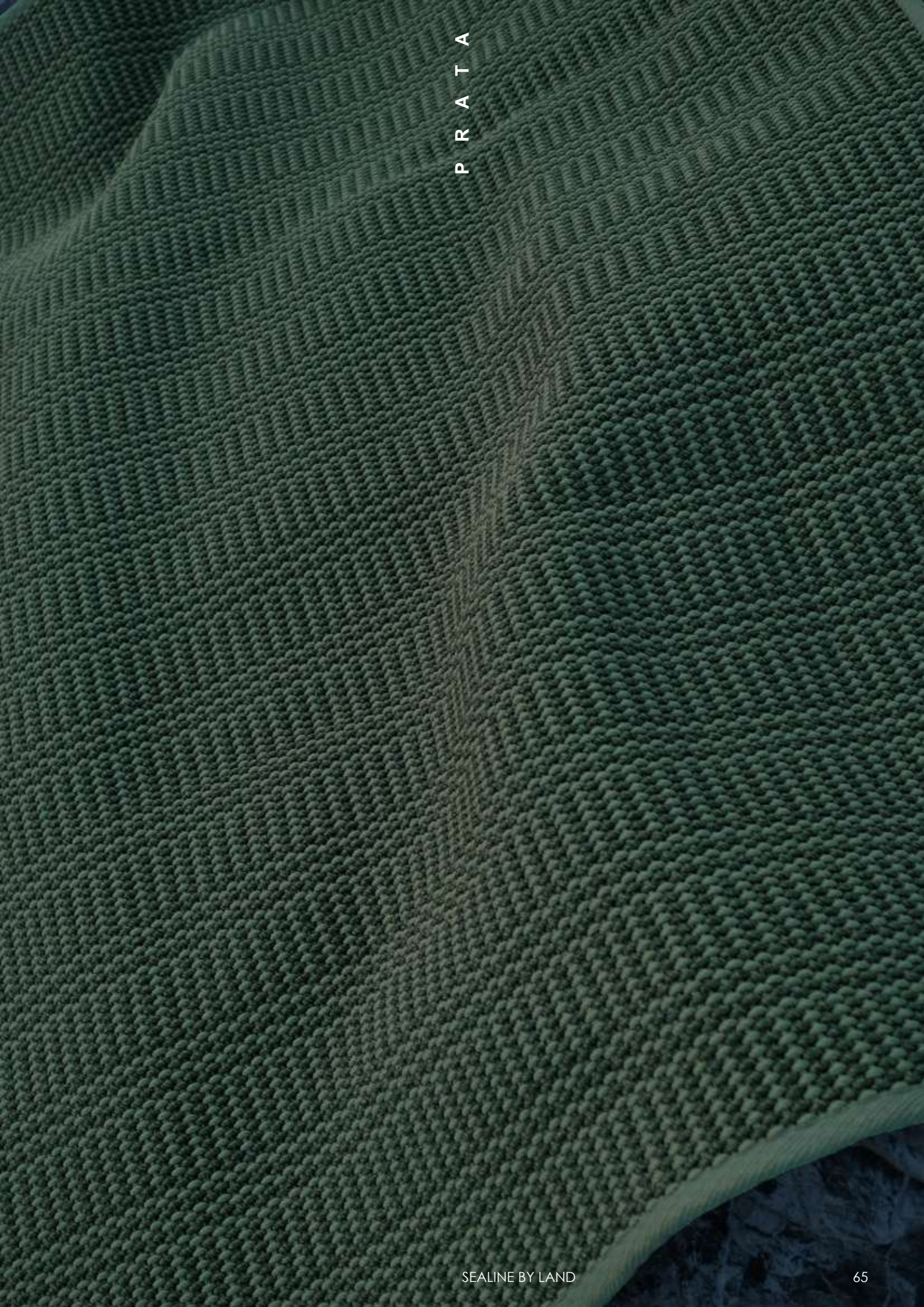
